Pastoral Letter from Bishop Brian Mascord

My Sisters and Brothers

Today I address you on a serious matter that is causing many to feel hurt and bewildered.

As you may be aware it has been reported in various media outlets this week that a priest of our Diocese is the subject of charges of indecent assault against a child in 1993 at Fairfield.

The priest who has been charged is not currently involved in ministry or in any other Church activity.

A statement from NSW Police indicates that the matter will first appear in court for an initial hearing on 15 May 2019.

As this matter is before the court it is important that the criminal justice process is fully respected, and as such, and to respect privacy, further comment cannot be made at this time.

I wish to reassure you and the broader community of our total commitment as a Diocese to the care and protection of children, young people and vulnerable people. We have rigorous child protection processes in place across our Diocese and we will continue to take all appropriate steps to minimise the risk of harm to anyone in our care.
