SOCIAL JUSTICE STATEMENT



Pope Benedict XVI has spoken of the importance of "a renewed reflection on how rights presuppose duties, if they are not to become mere licence. Nowadays we are witnessing a grave inconsistency. On the one hand, appeals are made to alleged rights, arbitrary and non-essential in nature, accompanied by the demand that they be recognized and promoted by public structures, while, on the other hand, elementary and basic rights remain unacknowledged and are violated in much of the world".

Among those rights, the Pope emeritus points to "lack of food, drinkable water, basic instruction and elementary health care" (Caritas in Veritate, 43).
