Foundations for Missionary Leadership



Course Info

Foundations of Missionary Leadership is designed to empower and equip participants to develop the skills necessary to be missionary leaders in the Church today.

The course takes place over the course of the year, following the distinctive Aretè Centre methodology and philosophy to offer participants a unique and high quality course.

Our Philosophy

The Aretè Centre philosophy is expressed in three elements.

Encounter. Aretè prioritises providing opportunities to encounter God in a new way.

Formation. Aretè offers only the best level of formation, ensuring participants receive excellent instruction from qualified teachers.

Mission. All of our courses are geared towards practical application, and all students complete a mission placement as a part of their course.


Course Delivery

This course has three distinct modes of delivery.

Intensives occur four times throughout the course, providing a unique opportunity for encounter and community.

The **Weekly Classes** take place on a Wednesday evening. These workshop style sessions include a range of teaching styles, including lectures and interactive sessions.

The **Mission Placement** provides participants with a safe environment to put into practice what they learn, with the opportunity for feedback from an approved mentor.



Intensives

There are two different types of Intensives throughout the course.

The course starts with a **week long live-in conference**. This retreat provides participants with an opportunity to encounter God, and serves as the beginning of our first unit of study.

The three remaining intensives are **encounter weekends** taking place throughout the year. They will cover a range of topics, across a number of different units.



Course Outline

Unit 1: The Spirituality of Missionary Leadership

This unit explores the spiritual foundations of missionary leadership. The first intensive establishes a spirituality grounded in the initial proclamation of the love of God revealed in Christ and encountered through the Holy Spirit. The second intensive aims to help students deepen in the practices of prayer.

Mode:

Intensives 1 and 3 (see previous page for more details)

Unit 2: Theological Foundations for Mission in the Australian Context

This unit provides an overview of foundational theological principles for mission, beginning with the theology of mission arising from the teaching of the Second Vatican Council, and in the subsequent papal statements on mission. A model for mission for the present Australian context and grounded in these magisterial statements will be developed and evaluated.

Mode:

Face-to-face, or Online, Semester 1

Unit 3: Ministerial Leadership Theory and Praxis

In this unit students will learn what leadership grounded in Christian faith is, and begin to develop the leadership skills necessary for contemporary ministry.

Mode:

Face-to-face and Online, Semester 2

Unit 4: Electives

Students will have the opportunity to explore common practical skills for different ministries, before dividing into one of three elective streams: **youth ministry**, **adult evangelisation**, or **leading music in a faith community**.

Mode:

Intensives 2 and 4 (see previous page for more details)

Unit 5: Field Placement

This is a praxis unit for a supervised ministry placement. This unit develops a methodology and skills for ministry within the three elective streams, taking place within a particular ministry context.

Mode:

Semesters 1 and 2, with guidance from an approved supervisor.
