	Our Christian vocation or "calling" begins in our baptism, lived out either in single life, marriage, ordained ministry or consecrated life. The motto Pope Francis chose for himself as Bishop and Pope, miserando atque eligendo, means "having mercy, he called him", and the Pope constantly reminded us of the joyful message he experienced in his own life: in spite of our weaknesses and sins, Jesus, our Good Shepherd, has looked upon us with perfect love and mercy and called us to follow him. Each year the Pope writes a message to the whole Church for this day. In his final message for this day Pope Francis wrote:	
	"Dear friends, the world pushes you to make hasty decisions and bombards you with a constant blare that prevents you from experiencing a silence that is open to God who speaks to the heart. Have the courage to pause, to listen to what your heart tells you, and to ask God about his dreams for you. The silence of prayer is indispensable if we are to learn how to hear God's call amid the specific circumstances of our lives and to respond consciously and freely." <a href="https://dow.sh/gss25">https://dow.sh/gss25</a>

	In 2015, Pope Francis wrote that "charity and mercy demand that the Church, like a good mother, be near her children who feel themselves estranged from her." The Inter-diocesan Tribunal of Sydney, which has an Office in the Diocese of Wollongong, is a service of the Church to assist with the pastoral care of Catholics and non-Catholics who are civilly divorced, and who are seeking to remarry or who want clarification of their standing in the Church. The Tribunal also assists remarried persons seeking to have their current marriage recognised in the Church, and remarried persons wishing to be baptised or received into the Catholic Church. Any divorced person, or a divorced and remarried person is welcome to contact the Wollongong Office of the Tribunal to obtain further information, or to have their status within the Church clarified. Brochures are available from the church foyer or notice board area. The Wollongong Office of the Tribunal is open Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays.
