NEW	Please Support Father David's urgent appeal for Stem Cell Donors. On Wednesday (9 April) Fr David Catterall (Emeritus Parish Priest of Oran Park) will receive a stem cell transplant for his Acute Myeloid Leukaemia. Each year, over 1,100 Australians, like Fr David, search for a stem cell donor to potentially save their life. Australia's small donor pool means only 80 patients are helped annually, leaving many struggling to find a match. A simple cheek swab, conveniently sent to your home, could change someone's life helping you become a source of HOPE - in this Jubilee year. The Inter-diocesan Tribunal of Sydney, which has an Office in the Diocese of Wollongong, is a service of the Church to assist with the pastoral care of Catholics and non-Catholics who are civilly divorced, and who are seeking to remarry or who want clarification of their standing in the Church. The Tribunal also assists remarried persons seeking to have their current marriage recognised in the Church, and remarried persons wishing to be baptised or received into the Catholic Church. Any divorced person, or a divorced and remarried person is welcome to contact the Wollongong Office of the Tribunal to obtain further information, or to have their status within the Church clarified.
