It includes a prayer, designed to make it seem genuine, and a "request that must be managed discreetly". Eventually the scammer asks for money, or gift cards, or similar. It is easy for scammers to set up an email address and then sign off with the name of a priest, so please be wary of this scam.</li> <li>Also, note that my email address, <i>firstname.surname@dow.org.au</i> is the standard format of an email address for a priest of our Diocese. If ever in doubt, please contact the Parish Office before replying to a message.
